What is an STSM ?

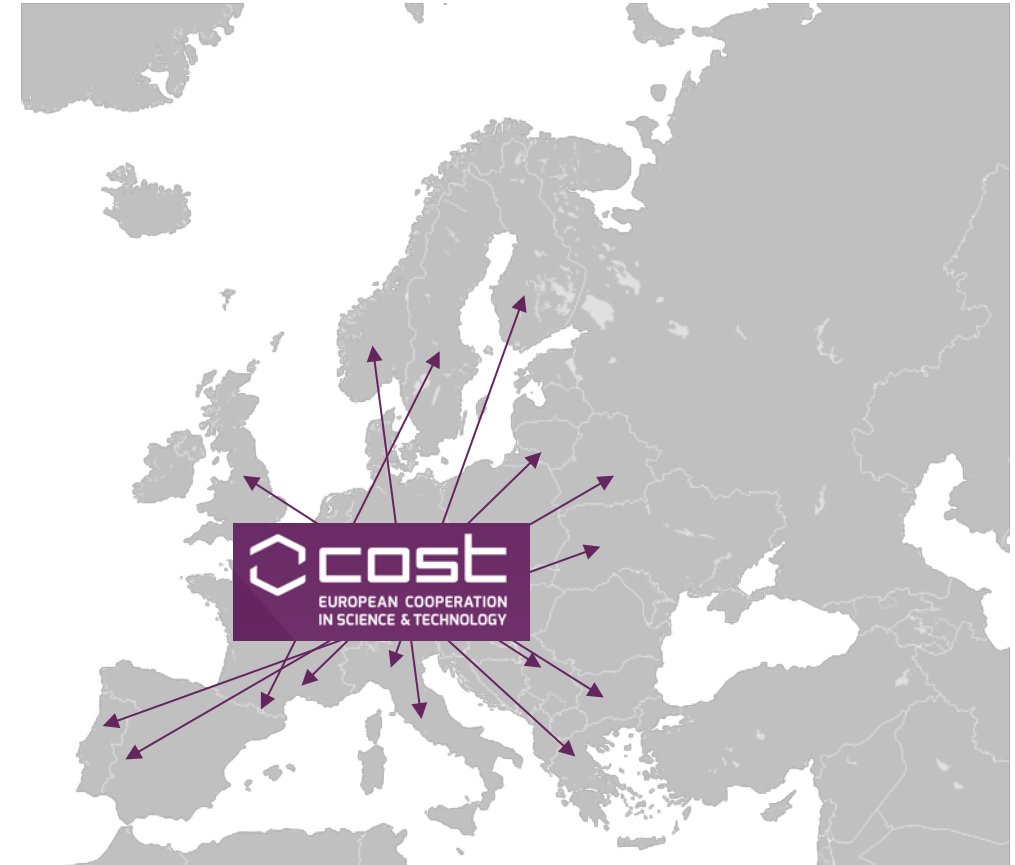


- ✓ **Short Term Scientific Missions (STSM)** are COST networking tools aimed at increasing collaborations through **exchange of researchers between Partners**.
- ✓ STSMs are exchange visits fostering collaboration, **contributing to the scientific objectives of the Action** and allowing participants to learn new techniques and to have access to data/instruments/methods not available in their own institution/company.
- ✓ **Each STSM has to be started and concluded in the same Grant Period**

COST distinguishes between two types of STMS:

- **Normal STSM** one (up to 90 days – 2500€ max contribution)
- **Early Career Investigator (ECI) STSM** (up to 180 days 3500€ max contribution)

→ a researcher whose career span less than 8 years between the date of the PhD/doctorate (or similar experience) and the date of involvement in the COST Action.



What is an STSM ?

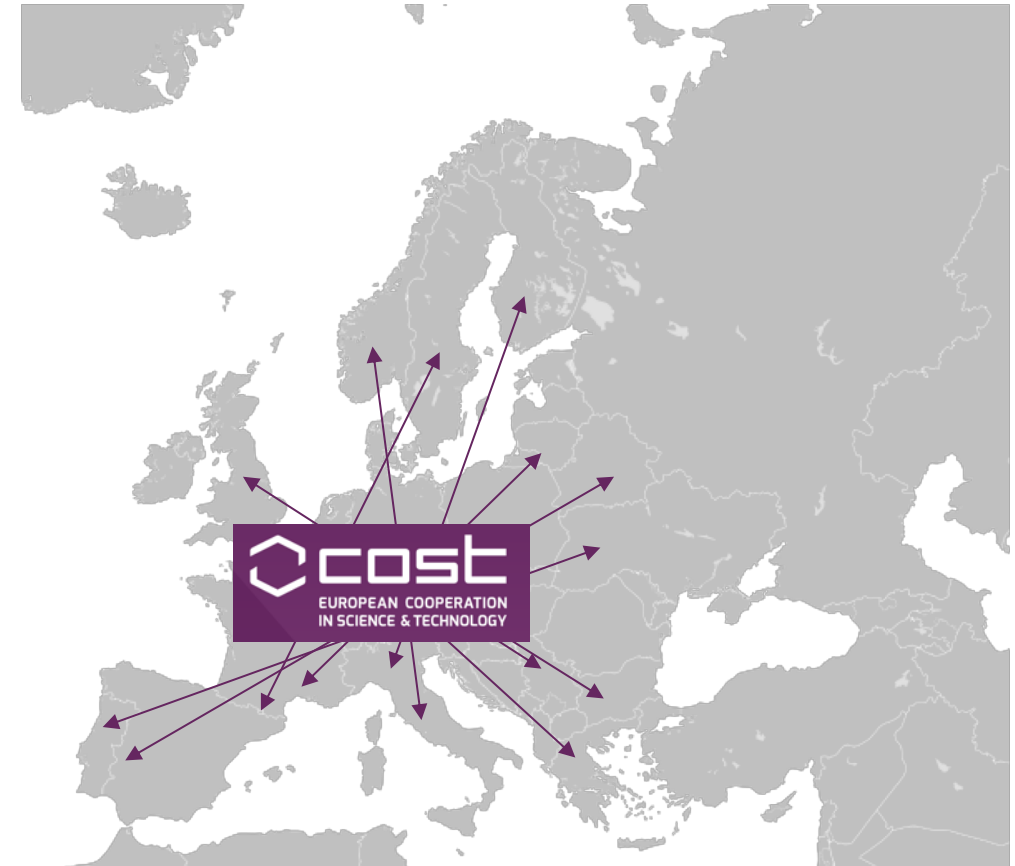


STSMs can be from a COST Action participating COST country:

- to another participating COST country
- to an approved near neighbour country institution and vice versa
- to an approved international partner country institution
- to an approved European Organisation (and vice versa in case of RTD organizations)

To successfully complete the STSM and to receive the reimbursement, the grantees have to provide

- a **short scientific report** about their work
- a **Confirmation letter** by the host institution of the successful execution of the STSM



In ActInPak, after STSM, in addition to previous documentation, the grantees are required:

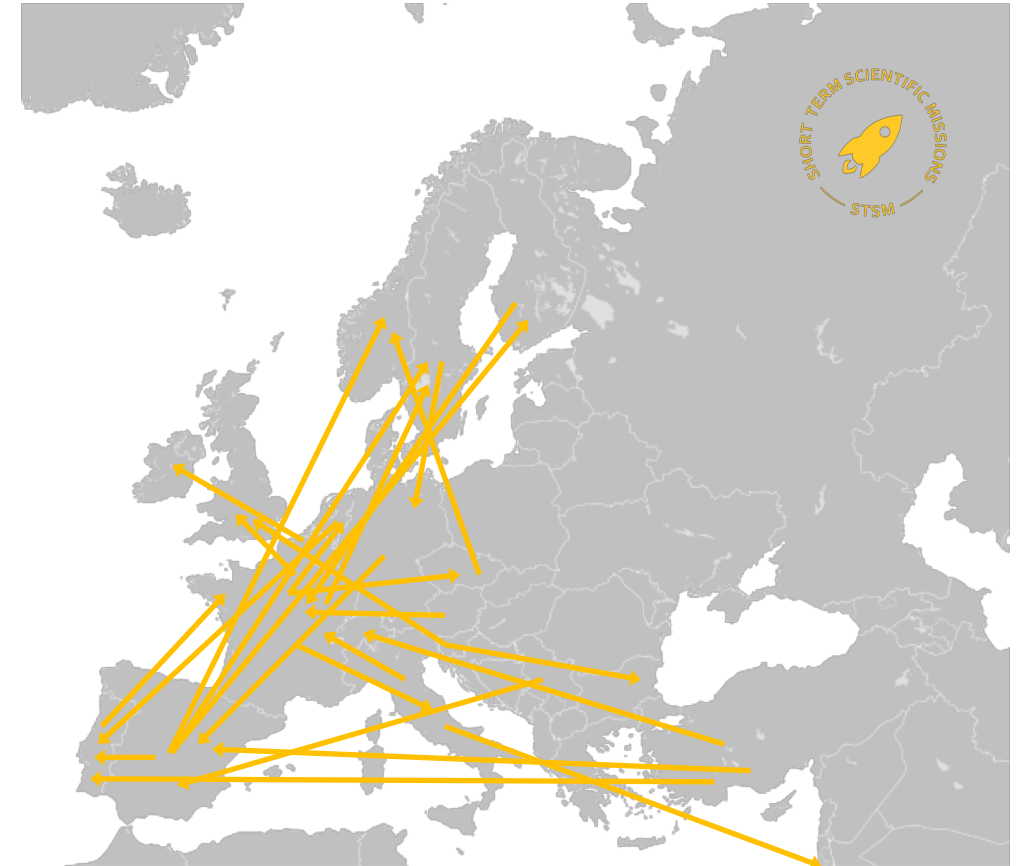
- to give a **presentation** during an ActInPak meetings
- to prepare a **video pod cast** for the ActInPak website.
- A short **statement** about their STSM experience
